6	Q. (BY MR. ALEXANDER) Mr. Hine, you
7	acknowledge you're still under oath?
8	A. Yes.
9	Q. John, you had indicated to me before we
10	got back on the record that there was some testimony
11	regarding NORM that you wanted to clarify. Would you
12	do so at this time.
13	A. We have had NORM testing on the property,
14	and the field has been because of something
15	unrelated to us has been found to have NORM on it
16	somewhere in the field. I'm not aware of where that
17	is.
18	The way the state does that is if you
19	have a NORM if you have one place in the whole
20	field that has NORM on it by test, then it's a NORM
21	field.
22	MR. MINYARD: When you say field, what
23	are you referring to?
24	A. By field I mean north via south, via
25	anything that's properly in the Jeanerette Field
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- area, which is probably a 5 by 5 square mile area.
- Q. (BY MR. ALEXANDER) You don't know where
- 3 that NORM was found, do you?
- 4 A. No.
- 5 Q. We're going to come back --
- 6 MR. MINYARD: As far as documents,
- 7 it's my understanding that -- we don't have any
- 8 documents right now. But it's my understanding that
